

Free Meals

You may be eligible to receive free meals -

- If you are aged between 16-18
- 19-25 and are subject to a learning difficulty assessment (LDA), or Education Health Care Plan
- Are in receipt of, or have parents who are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:
 - Income Support
 - Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
 - Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
 - Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
 - Child Tax Credit, (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit), and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190 as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs
 - Working Tax Credit run-on: paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
 - Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7400, as assessed by earning from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)

To apply you are required to enter the following details:

- Parent/guardian name, address and contact details.
- National Insurance number or National Asylum Support Service reference number
- Student's name, date of birth and College

If applying independently you will be required to use your address and contact details.
