

Enrichment Opportunities

Aspects of Antiquity

This course offers an opportunity to look at some features of societies from the ancient world – primarily Neolithic, Egyptian, Greek, Roman, Celtic. Students will be able to explore the cultures and histories of these societies and judge whether ancient peoples really were different to modern humans. We will also look at how we are able to understand the past through use of evidence and archaeology.

Art - Unwind Your Mind

In this enrichment you have a time to be creative and use this time just for you. The session can be used to work on a passion project you have always wanted to explore, or you may wish to develop on existing work from one of your A level subjects. You may want to create a political project, installation work, a short film, a series of paintings or prints. You could design clothing or start a webpage or blog. This is your time, and there is support to help you create something exciting and personal to you. This workshop will include meditation and down time to keep you happy and healthy.

Art Professional Practice

Exhibitions often look effortless, but don't fall for this tempting assumption. Putting together a show is a lot of work, and if you don't know what you're in for, you might find yourself in over your head. This course teaches you how to mount your first exhibition, put together portfolio's, investigate online blogging, live client briefs, promotional materials, exhibits and websites. So, if you're curious about curating but put-off by the lack of knowledge then this would be a great thing for you to do. This also looks fantastic on personal statements if you are wanting to combine an arts subject with a business perspective

Business & Football

Football clubs are now businesses and need to be run as businesses, especially with Financial Fair Play rules. The enrichment will cover a wide variety of business related themes. For example how football clubs are funded, the different types of ownership and their objectives and other interesting things (Forest Green Rovers - ethics, Wrexham takeover by Rob McElhenney and Ryan Reynolds, Chelsea and Abramovich, Manchester United and their share price, Man City and the ownership). There are loads of things to investigate. Also there will be a fantasy football league running alongside. Would need to be in an IT room.

Carbon Literacy

Carbon Literacy is the underpinning knowledge required to create this vital shift in how we live, work and study. The Project is built on the principle that learners who are Carbon Literate will have an embedded and instinctive understanding of the carbon impacts of their activities and will therefore make more informed choices about the most energy and resource efficient and lowest carbon options available to them. Students have the opportunity to be certified as 'Carbon Literate', by providing evidence that they understand and have embedded their understanding of the Project.

Cipher club

Run by the University of Southampton from September to January, the Challenge allows you to work on your own, or as part of a team, competing against students from across the country, solving puzzles where you have to decipher messages using ever more complex ciphers.

Creative Writing

Want to be a writer but not sure where to start? Have a trilogy of books in your head but struggle to get the first word down? This enrichment will give you the chance to develop your skills, learn about the craft of writing, and even beat the dreaded writer's block. You'll be writing in a variety of genres, from gothic to dystopia to comedy, looking at short stories, poems, plays and TV scripts, discussing and sharing work with your fellow writers.

Cross Stitch

Cross Stitch is one of the easiest forms of needlework as it combines a simple, straight stitch with a fabric that has evenly spaced holes to pass the thread through. It is a good mindfulness activity, good for reducing stress and can help with anxiety. You can follow a pattern or be creative and create your own masterpiece! Create bookmarks, pictures, or even presents!

Debating Society

Our friendly debating society take on a huge range of topics, from science to sport, and ethics to politics. Whether you'd like to debate, question, chair or judge... we have a role for you!

Duke of Edinburgh

It's not too late to join either the **Silver or the Gold Award for Duke of Edinburgh** and even with the lockdown, you can continue with most of the sections easily. We have a good number of students on Silver and currently just enough to have our first Gold group! Please note, doing your Bronze Award is not a prerequisite.

Embroidery

Embroidery is a beautiful craft which has existed for hundreds of years. As well as being a lovely skill to learn, it also has proven theraputic benefits as its calm rhythms and creative elements have been shown to reduce stress and anxiety. In this course we start by learning a few basic stitches. You then get the chance to create your own designs and spend time working on these. All materials are provided. This enrichment runs every week and you can join - or leave - at any time.

English - Further

Further English is a weekly seminar aimed primarily at students wanting to study English Literature at university, although all are welcome. The course offers a chronological overview of English Literature, starting with the Anglo-Saxons and finishing with the modernist writers of the early twentieth century.

English as a Foreign Language

English is spoken almost everywhere as a second languages. Knowing the techniques of how to teach is a great skill to have when it comes to subsidise your Gap Year or travels abroad. This course will introduce you to lesson planning and methodology to help you to teach your own language to others.

It will be suitable to anyone who wants to add a linguistic skillset to their CV.

Entrepreneurship and Starting a Business

A course for students who already have a business concept, or who have a strong desire to start their own business. Especially relevant to business students on A Level or Vocational courses but all who are passionate about starting businesses are welcome. The course will cover the following: Business Concept- Identifying and developing your business idea Business Plan – How to write a "killer" business plan that will provide clarity and funding Market Research and Marketing – Understanding your market. Meaningful research and analysis that validates, changes or refines your business concept.

Esports Enrichment/Escapism/Competitive

Do you enjoy gaming for fun? If you sign up to this enrichment, you'll spend one hour a week gaming with either your friends or on your own in our state of the art esports arena. We have Overwatch, League of Legends, Rocket League, Valorant, Apex Legends, Fallguys, FIFA and Fortnite to choose from.

Fashion Production

Interested in fashion? Do you want to make your own clothing? This is the ideal enrichment for all Textile students to learn fabric types, properties, stitches, seams, hems, fastenings and how to clone your wardrobe!

<u>First Aid</u>

Get a qualification in First Aid Training, and develop your confidence and knowledge as a first aider- an excellent skill for so many jobs!

Forensic Psychology

Forensic Psychology (from offence to rehabilitation) - A broad overview of the reality of forensic psychology and the processes that forensic psychologists can assist with. This enrichment includes the 'Behind Bars' conference and other guest speakers. Forensic Psychology will broaden your understanding of psychological concepts and supports transition into careers/further education.

GCSE Maths Workshop

Maths GCSE Workshop - This enrichment is for students retaking Maths GCSE and will provide an additional opportunity to practise past paper questions in preparation for the November exams. You will be able to gain additional help on any areas you are struggling with or have the opportunity to try harder questions from the ends of papers.

Gentle Gym

Get involved with our onsite Gym facilities and learn how to use the equipment

German for Holidays

This course for complete beginners covers introductions, talking about your family and your town, asking for directions, travel and transport, ordering food in a restaurant, booking accommodation, and German traditions.

Italian for Holidays

A short course which will help you to learn how to get by in Italian. Focus on holidays and situations you may face when travelling in Italy.

<u>Japanese</u>

Course for those wishing to learn Japanese from scratch, covering conversation, comprehension, and writing skills as well as cultural aspects. Can lead to Japanese GCSE in Year 2 for those interested.

Law Mock Trial

The Law Mock Trial enrichment offers students an exciting opportunity to take part in a National Bar Mock Trial competition. This competition helps young people understand how the law touches every aspect of their lives, gaining an insight into how the legal justice system works. Students will be given access to resources and specially written criminal cases which are used to help the team prepare for competition. The team will then take part in a regional heat and go head-to-head with other schools to prosecute and defend the cases, usually in November/December or January/February depending on which heat the college is allocated to. Winning teams will then compete in a National Final which usually takes place in May/June.

Lifeguarding (NPLQ)

Gain a qualification alongside your studies and qualify as a lifeguard.

Minecraft 4 All

An inclusive and accessible session with opportunities to explore the creative side of MC and get involved in build competitions. Suitable for all levels of experience with a focus on creative builds.

Minecraft Madness

Experienced crafters will have the opportunity to explore and contribute to the maps on our QMC Minecraft server, created and tested by our build team. It is also home to the QMCentaurs, the first college Minecraft esports team. Whether you are a competitive player, a creative builder or both, there is a place for you here in our community.

Music Theory

Offered to students across the college who would like to know more about the theory of music. The class will be tailored to participants and is open to complete beginners to Grade V and higher. For higher grades we will study the ABRSM syllabus supporting those who may wish to enter for exams privately.

There will then be rehearsals every week from then until the performances.

Playwriting Enrichment

Students will get the chance to develop and write their own play as part of the National Theatre New Views project. You will also watch live performances and work with a playwright from the National to help shape and develop your ideas before turning them into a final play.
